The 7th edition of the EAST AFRICA PHARMA EXPO 2023 – an international exhibition on COMPLETE pharma manufacturing - was held during October 3 & 4, 2023 at KICC, Nairobi, Kenya. Africa is the only pharmaceutical market where genuinely high growth is still achievable, value of Africa's pharmaceutical industry jumped to USD 28.56 billion in 2017 from just USD 5.5 billion a decade earlier. That growth is continuing at a rapid pace: we predict the market will be worth USD 56 billion to USD 70 billion by 2030. An improvement GMP (Good Manufacturing Practices) compliance and adoption of novel technologies has been observed. The East African pharma industry is keen on growing local manufacturing and this can be seen through the various initiatives from member states. One of such efforts geared towards increasing the capacity and volume of pharmaceutical manufacturing in Eastern Africa is by the organization of events such as the East Africa Pharma Expo.

Objective of the East Africa Pharma Expo: To bring together stakeholders – pharmacy industry and fraternity, regulators and technology solution providers, to connect and explore information and trade opportunities.

POSITION OF THE REGULATORY AUTHORITIES

- East harmonization and promoting self-reliance within the East African member states. The fast-tracking of product registration and the licensing of local manufacturers and listing of GMP facilities from joint GMP Inspections towards achievement of our regional goals for local pharma manufacturing.
- The formation of AMA (Africa Medicines Agency) should have an administrative structure that include regional forums that support pro Africa based pharmaceutical production
- Policies should aim at encouraging consumption of locally manufactured health commodities and create market demand for consumption local manufacturers to satisfy regional demand
- Strengthening pharmacovigilance (PV) should be linked not only fault finding but be used as an appendices to strengthen capacity building and compliance through initiation of CAPA
- Human resource Capital
- Capacity building to support the skilled personnel requirements of the growing manufacturing industry. It was highlighted that there is need for collaboration between manufacturers and universities, to support the training of professionals that will support the growing industry and Encouragement of technology transfer

HIGHLIGHTS

Going local for commodity security

- About 35 licensed Local pharma manufacturers and more that 40 applications including two vaccine manufacturers
- Kenya is a preferred potential pharmaceutical investment candidate
- Local manufacturing is very important, as it provides security, especially during pandemics, as was seen during the COVID-19 time.
- FKPM (Federation of Kenya Pharmaceutical Manufacturers) mentioned that various factors need to be looked into, to create an enabling environment for the growth of local manufacturing. Some of these factors are such as; a favorable regulatory environment, intensifying the search for new markets and strengthening supply chain.
- the Ministry of Health (MOH) of Kenya stated that local manufacturer are able to meet 23% of Essential Medicines list and the opportunity to venture in local pharmaceutical manufacturing is big and open

EXHIBITION OF NOVEL TECHNOLOGIES BY TECHNOLOGY SOLUTION PROVIDERS


